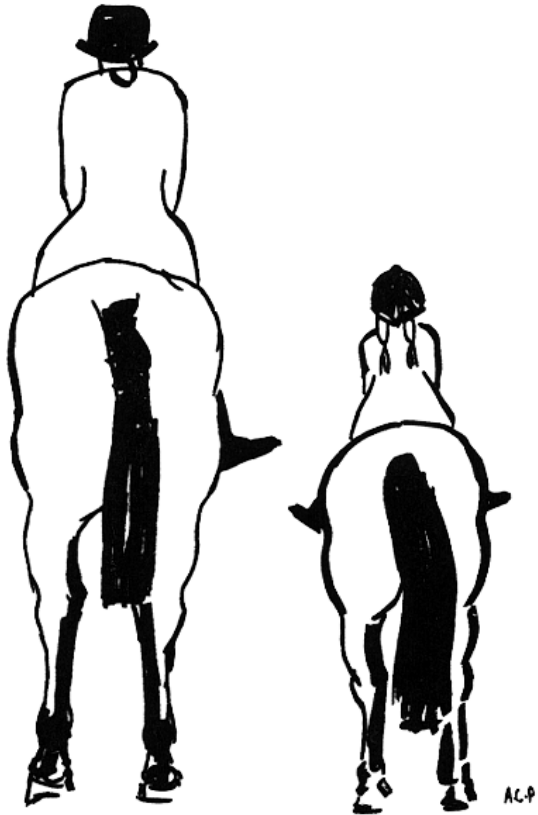

Main Ring

Children's Equitation Division "A" (2' height)—Champion and Reserve. Open to horses and ponies. Riders may not cross enter into the 2'6" Equitation Division. Country Lane Farm Perpetual Trophy to be awarded to the highest point rider.

Class 1—Children's Equitation "A" Fences. Fence height 2'

Class 2—Children's Equitation "A" Fences. Fence height 2'

Class 3—Children's Equitation "A" Flat

Children's Equitation Division "B" (2'6" height)—Champion and Reserve. Open to horses and ponies. Riders may not cross enter into the 2' Equitation Division. Bolling Perpetual Trophy to be awarded to the highest point rider.

Class 4—Children's Equitation "B" Fences. Fence height 2'6"

Class 5—Children's Equitation "B" Fences. Fence height 2'6"

Class 6—Children's Equitation "B" Flat

Short Stirrup Division—Champion and Reserve. Crossrails at 18". Hope Agnew Memorial Trophy to be awarded to highest point rider.

Class 7—Short Stirrup Flat. Walk, Trot and Canter

Class 8—Short Stirrup Fences

Class 9—Short Stirrup Fences

Walk/Trot/Canter Division—Champion and Reserve. Helen Castles Trophy to be awarded to the highest point rider. Riders ineligible for other divisions but can enter Family Classes, Pairs Walk Trot, Lucky Buck, Cola Classic and Costume Class. Riders will be asked to canter individually.

Class 10—Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation

Class 11—Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation

Class 12—Walk/Trot/Canter Poles. Trot or canter over four ground poles.

Walk/Trot Division—Champion and Reserve. Misty My Love Perpetual Trophy to be awarded to the highest point rider. Riders ineligible for other classes except Family Class, Pairs Walk Trot, and Costume Class

Class 13—Walk/Trot Equitation

Class 14—Walk/Trot Equitation

Class 15—Walk/Trot Pleasure

Class 16—Leadline Class. Riders ineligible for other classes except Family Class & Costume Class.

Class 17—Family Class. Walk only. 25% bonus for each generation. C.W. Kelsey Perpetual Trophy to be awarded to winning family. Cost \$40 per family.

Class 18—Family Horse or Pony. Entry to be ridden by two members of the same family. First member rides over fences; second rides on the flat. 50% bonus for two generations. Primrose Perpetual Memorial Trophy given in Memory of Mr. Henry J. Fisher. Cost \$40 per family

GRTA Division—Open to all adult members of the GRTA. You may become a GRTA member at the show. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Rockette Perpetual Trophy, donated by Betty Davies, to be presented to the rider receiving the most points in the division.

Class 19—GRTA Working Hunter Fences Alvin Untermeyer Perpetual Trophy

Class 20—GRTA Working Hunter Fences Joseph Wilshire Perpetual Trophy

Class 21—GRTA Pleasure Horse/Pony Kenneth R. Schall Perpetual Trophy

Class 22—GRTA Working Hunter Flat Robert Cornell Perpetual Challenge Trophy

Class 23—Pairs Over Fences. Horses to be ridden tandem. Last fence taken abreast. Lalande McC. Keeshan Perpetual Memorial Trophy

Class 24—Pairs Walk, Trot. Performance and appearance to count.

Class 25—Bloody Mary Class. 21 years or older. To be judged at the walk, trot, canter and jump. First prize to the rider left with the fullest glass.

Class 26—Cola Classic. Riders 20 years old or younger. To be judged at the walk, trot, canter and over fences. First prize to the rider left with the fullest glass.

Class 27—Lucky Buck. Open to all ages. We provide a buck under the knee. First prize wins 50% of receipts. Walk, trot, canter and jump while riding bareback.

Class 28—Costume Class. Open to all ages, riders and non-riders. Helmets required on horseback.
