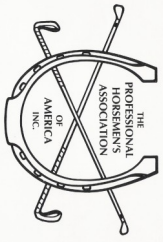

HISTORY OF THE GREENWICH HORSE SHOW

First held in 1914, the Greenwich Horse Show celebrates its 90th anniversary this year. Although not a consecutive run, it is an impressive one.

First held in Port Chester at Nutbourne Farm, one of the features, a tradition continued today, was a luncheon given under a large tent on the show grounds.

In 1925 the show moved to the Greenwich Polo Club Grounds, on Quaker Ridge in Greenwich. In 1948 the show relocated briefly to the Blind Brook Turf and Polo Club on Anderson Hill Road in Purchase, NY before returning to Quaker Ridge in 1950 for a few years and then back to Blind Brook for the 38th running in 1954.

In 1960, after a five year absence, the GRTA June Show was held on the property of Mr. William Heron at Lower Cross Road and Lake Avenue. After the Heron family sold their property, the show was moved in the late 1970's to Coker Farm in Bedford, NY thanks to the generosity of Judy Richter.

In 1982, the Greenwich June Horse Show arrived at its current location when the Gerrish Milliken family welcomed us to their property on Pierson Drive.

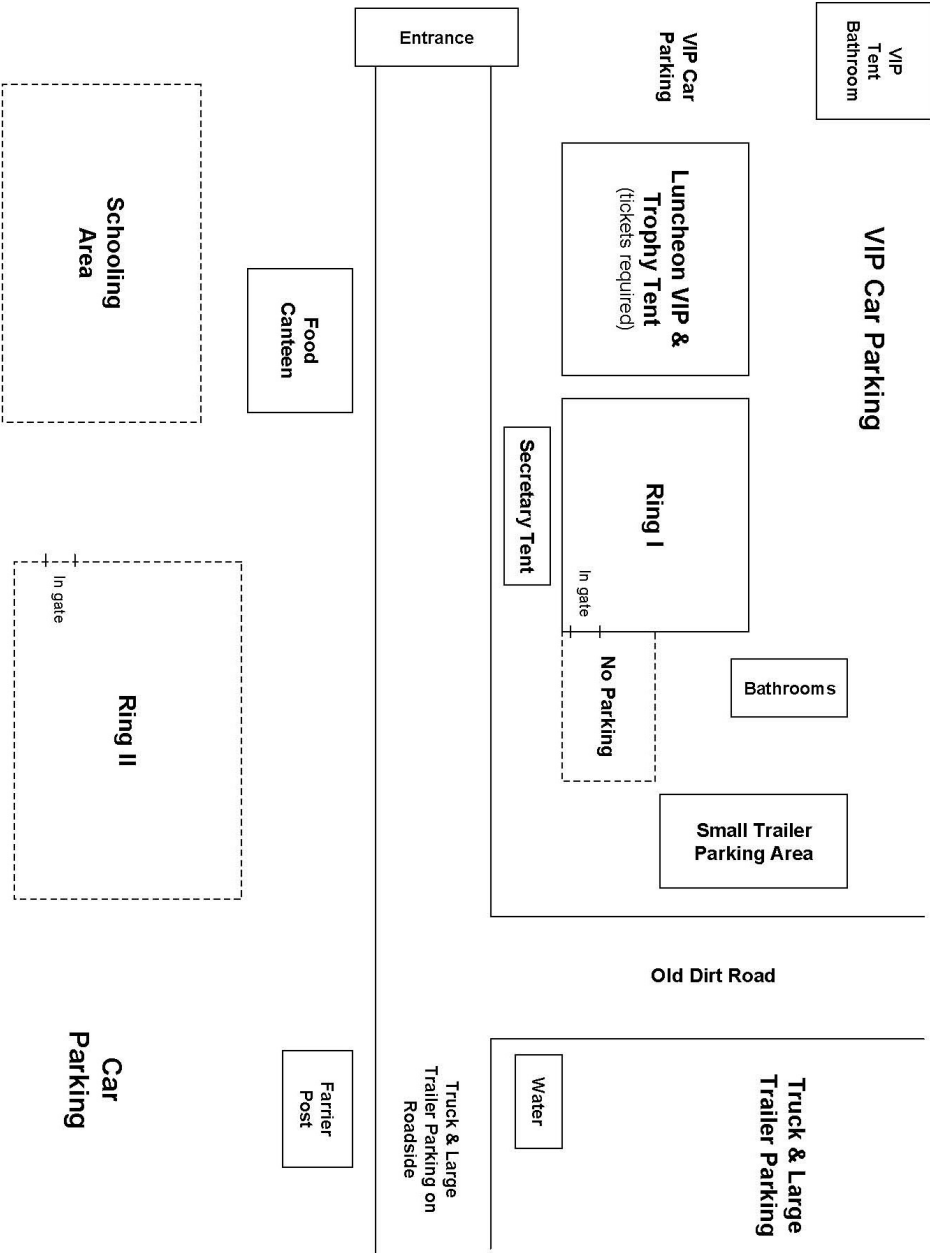

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT



Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.



Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and /or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and /or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Unless otherwise specified, all hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness.
- Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show management; but Greenwich Horse Show, GRTA, Milliken Family & BHC Management will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendant hold the competition, and its members, employees and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals or property at the show.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any classes if in its opinion the entries so warrant, while maintaining minimum USEF requirements to fill a class.
- Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a MANDATORY LINE. The same will be indicated on course diagrams and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.
- Riders must be members of ASPCA, CHJA and NEHC to compete in those respective medal classes. No membership requirement for NEHC Pleasure.
- Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA and/or NEHC will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA/NEHC Rules. To show in CHJA & NEHC Medal classes, riders MUST be members of the respective organization. In order to compete for CHJA/NEHC annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA/NEHC and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA/NEHC. A copy of the CHJA & NEHC Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net & www.nehc.info
- CHJA Recognizes Child Hunter, Adult Hunter, Junior Hunter, CT Working Hunter & CHJA Medals
- NEHC Recognizes "C" Child Hunter, Adult Hunter, Junior Hunter, NEHC Medals & NEHC Pleasure
- Exhibitors must possess current memberships for all organizations and classes which require the same. Any fine levied against the horse show for invalid memberships will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- Measurements by appointment with the on-call vet. Appointments must be made 48 hours prior to the show.
- No USEF or CHJA points awarded for M&S Hunter Classics.
- Any returned checks will be charged an additional fee of \$100.
- We request you leave your dogs at home. All dogs must be leashed and under control at all times. \$100 fine for loose dogs.
- All class specifications & membership applications available at the secretary's desk.
- No stabling available.
- Sharps containers must be used. Location available at the show office. Failure to properly dispose of medical waste shall result in a \$100 fine.
